Registration fee: \$125.00 per child, on or before March 1, 2023

If registration is after March 1, 2023, add \$100.00 per family

Supply Fee: \$140.00 per child in 3 yr old PS and 4 yr old PK

Book Fee: \$220.00 per child in grades K-8th

Technology Fee: \$100.00 per family

It is important that all families are able to send their children to St. Constance School, regardless of income level: therefore, financial assistance is available based on need. All families who would like to be considered for a tuition scholarship need to fill out a Common Application form, which is available in the school office, and complete the FACTS Financial Aid Application online.

The application is analyzed by FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Service.

2) **Fundraising** - To keep tuition rates as low as possible within Archdiocesan guidelines, the school board must develop fundraising events to make up the difference between what you pay for tuition and the actual cost of your child's education. Therefore, families must do what they can to participate in the fundraising activities of the school.

In addition, there are also examples of activities to participate in <u>without spending anything</u>: 1) *Recruit new students* by sharing your positive St. Constance School experiences with others. For 2023-2024, a \$250 tuition discount will be applied for families referring a new family who registers to SCS. 2) *Scan* Box Tops for Education for the school. <u>If everyone participates</u>, the rewards to the school add up quickly! It all comes together if we all work together towards the same goal!



- 3) **Service Hour Program** –Each school family is required to work fifteen (15) volunteer hours to the school between May 1, 2023 and April 30, 2024. You will be informed through school correspondence of the many volunteer opportunities available. Each time you work service hours you will be given a coupon. It is your responsibility to be aware of volunteer opportunities and to keep track of your service coupons. If you have been unable to work the required fifteen (15) hours, a \$350.00 fee will be assessed to your account on May 1, 2024. No partial hours will be accepted. Fifteen (15) volunteer hours must be worked to avoid paying the \$350.00 fee.
- 4) School Board, Home and School Association and Sports Association The St. Constance School Board, Home and School Association and Sports Association will sponsor a variety of fun events throughout the school year. Your participation and support of these events is important. The money raised by these organizations is used to improve our school, enhance the programs offered here, and help keep the cost of tuition down.
